

## **ACCUPLACER National Conference June 28-30, 2012 Call for Proposals: Guidelines and Instructions**

Areas of interest and examples include:

- **Revealing Potential**

*Tell your colleagues about your student success models, or about how you have used ACCUPLACER in developmental education programs.*

- **Expanding Opportunity**

*Have you had success using ACCUPLACER as a recruitment or retention tool? Do you have a state-wide model for ACCUPLACER adoption that you would like to share?*

- **Enrichment and Best Practices**

*Do you have best practices for uploading ACCUPLACER data to your campus information management system? How about innovative methods for setting and evaluating cut scores? What is your experience using both CLEP and ACCUPLACER? Do you have research using ACCUPLACER as a model?*

- **Innovative Strategies**

*Share innovative strategies and case studies that you have implemented at your institution for ACCUPLACER Diagnostics, ACCUPLACER//MyFoundations Lab, WritePlacer, CSP.*

### **Session Structure**

Concurrent sessions will be scheduled at 60-minute intervals. Presentations should encourage audience participation.

- **Single Presentation:** One speaker presenting research findings, reporting on a specific program, or providing training in a specific area.
- **Panel:** Two-to-four speakers presenting research findings, reporting on specific programs, or debating on specific issues.

### **Please use the following outline as a format for your proposal:**

1. **Title of Presentation:** Please provide a title (10 words maximum) that accurately conveys the content of the session.

2. Description of Presentation: Provide a brief, 50-word description that can be included in the conference program.
3. Content of Presentation: Provide a 200-word description of the content and the activities involved in your presentation.
4. Description of Presenter(s): Provide a brief summary of the background and current position of all presenters. Please include name, title, affiliation, address, telephone number, fax number, and e-mail address.
5. Equipment: It is highly recommended that all presenters bring their own laptops. An LCD projector will be provided.
6. PLEASE NOTE: The College Board will make the Speaker Presentation session materials available to all ACCUPLACER users. By submitting your materials, you consent to the College Board's distribution of these materials and affirm that you are the author of the materials and have the rights to give this consent. If you have included any (copyrighted) content in the materials that you do not own, please inform the College Board at the time of your submission.
