Help us recognize the individuals in our region who make a difference. We are currently seeking nominations for the following awards:

The Martha H. Salmon Leadership Award

recognizes an individual whose service and leadership at the regional and national levels has continuously advanced the mission of the College Board, and who has demonstrated significant contributions and service by advocating equity, access and opportunity for all students.

The Excellence in Service Award recognizes a professional from a member institution for exemplary contributions to and achievements in the Southwestern Region. Award recipients must be from a member institution; demonstrate significant positive impacts on their profession and colleagues; exhibit leadership and service; mentor, inspire and/or motivate others; participate and contribute to the Southwestern Regional and College Board forums, workshops, conferences and activities; and demonstrate a positive contribution to the mission and focus of an appropriate assembly.

Please consider nominating a colleague for an Excellence in Service Award from one of our three assemblies:

- The Academic Assembly award winner must demonstrate advocacy for universal access to high standards of learning.
- The College Scholarship Service Assembly award winner must be active in promoting access to postsecondary education by assisting students and parents in preparing financially for college.
- The Guidance and Admission Assembly award winner must demonstrate leadership in facilitating student transition between secondary and postsecondary education.

The AP[®] Award recognizes individuals who have demonstrated significant involvement with the AP Program, including AP Coordinators, counselors, Pre-AP[®] teachers and AP teachers. Please note that this is limited to four AP awards per year.

The AP Award for Administrators recognizes an individual who has demonstrated significant positive impacts on the AP Program within their school or district; supports and promotes the professional development of teachers, counselors and AP Coordinators; and participates and contributes to the Southwestern Regional and College Board forums, workshops, conferences and activities.

Award Selection and Presentation

In December, a subcommittee of the Southwestern Regional Council will review the nominations and select the recipients. To ensure that your nomination is accepted, please complete the entire form. Nominations are limited to one additional page. Award recipients will be selected in December. Awards will be presented to the recipients Feb. 2–3, 2012, at the Southwestern Regional Forum in Little Rock, Ark., February 2-3, 2012. The nominee will be required to send in additional information.
