Awards will be presented to the recipients at the Southwestern Regional Forum in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, February 4–6, 2009. The nominee will be required to send in additional information.

## Check **only one** award per nomination.

- Martha H. Salmon Leadership Award**—Recognizes an individual whose service and leadership at the regional and national levels have continuously advanced the mission of the College Board and who has demonstrated significant contributions and service by advocating for equity, access, and opportunity for all students.
- Excellence in Service Award**—Recognizes a professional from a member institution for exemplary contributions to and achievements in the Southwestern Region. Award recipients must be from a member institution; demonstrate significant positive impacts on their profession and colleagues; exhibit leadership and service; mentor, inspire, and/or motivate others; participate and contribute to the Southwestern Regional and College Board forums, workshops, conferences, and activities; and demonstrate a positive contribution to the mission and focus of an appropriate assembly.

Please check one assembly:

- The Academic Assembly award winner must demonstrate advocacy for universal access to high standards of learning.
- The College Scholarship Service Assembly award winner must be active in promoting access to postsecondary education by assisting students and parents in preparing financially for college.
- The Guidance and Admission Assembly award winner must demonstrate leadership in facilitating student transition between secondary and postsecondary education.
- AP® Award**—Recognizes individuals who have demonstrated significant involvement with the AP Program, including AP Coordinators, administrators, counselors, Pre-AP® teachers, and AP teachers. Limited to no more than four AP awards per year.
